Inmate Commissary

Inmates have the ability to purchase personal items during their incarceration that are not furnished by the Floyd County Jail. Eligible inmates will be allowed to purchase candy, beverages, snacks, food items, general merchandise and hygiene items on a scheduled basis each week.

On every Tuesday of each week, commissary slips will be handed out to those who wish to purchase commissary. This list will be picked up the same night at the end of the shift and the orders will be placed into the Southern Sheriff's computer that night.

Commissary items will be delivered every Friday.

Commissary privileges may be suspended as part of the disciplinary process.

Inmate Accounts

Money orders are received at the jail through the mail or in a drop box located in the bonding lobby. Money may be applied to inmate accounts through a kiosk located in the visitation area or the bonding lobby as well. All money orders must include the inmate's name and ID number prior to being mailed or received by jail staff.
